

THE DISAPPEARING MAGIC WAND

Supplies needed:

1. Several copies of the other side of this sheet.
2. Scotch tape
3. A No.2 pencil
4. A pair of scissors
5. A sheet of newspaper
6. A grown up to help you

Making the Wand:

1. Make sure you make copies of the other side of this sheet before you begin.
2. Cut you paper along the dotted lines so that it looks like figure 1.
3. Second, turn the paper black-side down.
4. Begin rolling the paper around a No.2 pencil; roll it length-wise (fig. 2)
5. Once the entire paper is rolled into the shape of a wand, loosen the tension enough to make the wand about ½” in diameter.
6. Next, using a strip of scotch tape that is the same length as the black part of the wand, tape the wand in place (fig 3).
7. Remove the pencil.

Performing the Magic:

1. Show the audience the newspaper on both sides.
2. Next, roll the wand up inside the newspaper much like you rolled the pencil inside of the paper wand.
3. Make a magical pass over the paper; then tear it up.
4. The wand will just get torn with the newspaper, and the audience will think that the wand disappeared.

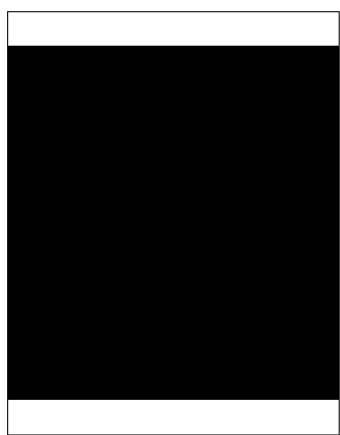

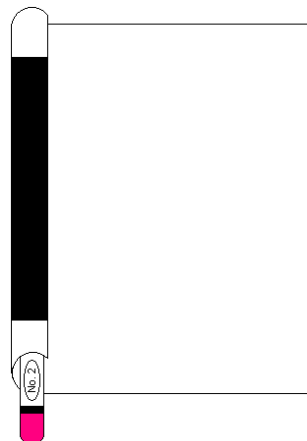

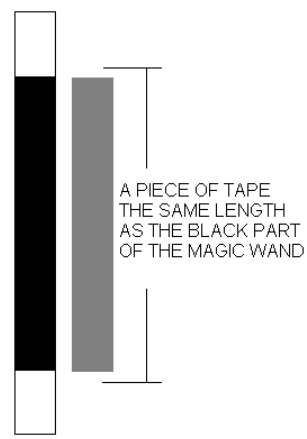
